Statement

it should not be the case that when life throws problems at us we should just accept it. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday today and forever (Hebrews 13:8), therefore if he gave us a vision for the future then that should not change because God does not change his mind (Numbers 23:19).

Unleashing the power of God

Psalms 115: 3

God fed the Israelites meat for a month in the desert.

Numbers 11:23

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Gods word always comes to pass, even when we don't see how.

Jeremiah 32: 17

Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

Jeremiah puts the last 3 examples in one

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Consider Genesis 2:7 – God creates man

God breathed into the mans nostrils "the breath of life".. Thereby placing the same breath he used in creation into a man

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God could have spoken man into being with breath like he did with the animals God breathed into the mans nostrils "the breath of life".. Thereby placing the same breath he used in creation into a man

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He re-used the previously created resource (soil) to create man.

God breathed into the mans nostrils "the breath of life".. Thereby placing the same breath he used in creation into a man

The word of God is therefore a container of the breath of God, the spirit of God.

Unleashing the power in Gods word

- > Trust in God alone as your source.
